Dear Property Owner,

It's a pleasure to provide you with safe, reliable, reasonably priced electric service. Keeping trees away from power lines is one of the most important ways to ensure you receive reliable electric service. Trees that grow too close to power lines can cause power outages and present risks, including fire.

Rocky Mountain Power will soon be conducting tree maintenance in the **Weber Canyon** area. Tall growing trees directly below the power lines will be removed and healthy trees adjacent to the power lines will be pruned. Pruning is designed to direct future growth away from the power lines and maintain tree health. The amount we prune depends on tree species, growth characteristics and power line voltage.

All trees that pose a fire hazard, or are a continued threat to public safety will be removed. All wood will be left on site. In locations where access is available, resulting brush will be chipped. In areas without access, resulting brush will be left in a manner that will not contribute to fuel loading or fire risk. All deciduous trees and brush removed will be treated to prevent future growth. The herbicide is registered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and will be applied in accordance with label requirements and federal, state and local regulations.

Our tree crews are professionally trained in modern tree-pruning techniques and safe work practices. They follow guidelines set by the American National Standard for Tree Care Operations and the International Society of Arboriculture. Rocky Mountain Power has been recognized by the National Arbor Day Foundation as a Tree line USA recipient for 12 consecutive years. This recognition is given to utilities for professional vegetation management practices.
